Lviv Defense Cluster – is a professional volunteer organization created at the beginning of the full-scale russian invasion in 2022. The Ministry of Defense of Ukraine appointed Lviv Defence Cluster as the main coordinator of the volunteer movement for the production of bulletproof vests.

Since February 2022, LDC has **manufactured and handed for free** about **100,000** certified bulletproof vests to the Defense and Security Forces of Ukraine. MISSION – is to protect those who defend Ukraine. VISION – is to provide warriors, police officers, rescuers, medics and other professionals working near the front line, with appropriate personal protection.

### PRODUCTION


At the request of the military and government agencies, we have organized and coordinated the production of personal protective equipment in Ukraine. This enables cluster companies to save jobs and support the economy.





### Anti-debris <mark>medical</mark> vests

Are essential for the work of emergency medical professionals who, together with rescuers, are the first to arrive in areas of shelling and destruction.

A large number of medics were killed or injured during the full-scale war.

In 2023, with the help of our partners: the RDI Foundation, the Latvian Foundation "Help for LDC", DATA Group and Nova Poshta and the people of Latvia, LDC managed to produce and deliver more than 3,000 more bulletproof vests. Humanitarian mission of LDC team to Zaporizhzhia and Dnipro

**LDC's anti-debris vests** have been **delivered to medics** in Luhansk,Kherson,Kharkiv,Sumy,Donetsk,Dnipropetrovs'k, Chernihiv, Zaporizhzhia, Odesa, Mykolaiv regions etc.

And also — Kyiv hospitals: "Okhmatdyt" (whose doctors take part in the evacuation of seriously injured children from the frontline areas) and the Heart Institute of the Ministry of Health of Ukraine (whose specialists regularly visit the de-occupied territories and settlements most affected by the hostilities).

# Projects that continued in 2023

LDC developed special bulletproof vests to evacuate children from the war zone.

This project was **the world's first** mass production of bulletproof vests for children. The vests, along with helmets of the required size, were handed over to the **Juvenile Prevention Unit of the National Police of Ukraine**. Since then, children have been evacuated in these protective kits.

In particular, in the Donetsk region, each police **evacuation crew** "White Angels" is equipped with children's protective kits.

Specialists from Lviv Defense Cluster, constructors from the Kharkiv Plant of Personal Protection Equipment and military expert Kalin Dimitrov were involved in the development and production of the children's bulletproof vest.

We were able to respond the request as quickly as possible thanks to the donors who supported the project – Ukrainians, as well as people from the United States of America, Canada, Britain, Poland, Luxembourg, Japan and other countries.

The Embassy of Ukraine in Japan and Ambassador Sergiy Korsunsky and The Renew Democracy Initiative Foundation provided special assistance. The Pomagam.pl and Uniters foundations also contributed to the project. TEDIS Ukraine provided logistical support. We are also grateful to Vasyl Bohdan (Head of the Juvenile Prevention Department), Vira Zamilyukhina and Torben Swane for their assistance.

### Handover of drones, cars and pouches

Total amount of transferred drones - 58 cars - 9 pouches for AK - 3500

The need for UAVs at the front is and remains enormous. LDC together with the International Relief and Rehabilitation Center have delivered many drones to Ukrainians as part of the **"1000 Drones for Ukraine"** project, including about 15 Mavic 3Ts, Mavic 3Es, and several dozen Kamikaze drones.

At the request of military units, LDC provides both standard pickup trucks and specialized vehicles, which we additionally equipped with armor plates to protect the crews.








### **Ohmatdyt - project "Children of war"**

• Amount of funds raised in 2023: UAH 1.6 million

#### • Results in 2023:

The roof was repaired on an area of 650 square meters. Project documentation for the overhaul of the premises with an area of more than 700 square meters was developed and approved.
